Dear Scholarship Coordinator

First, please discard any “Anthony Brucia Success Award” applications you may have collected previously. The three most critical changes are the address to which the applications are to be sent, the number of awards that will be given, and the amount of money for each award.

The San Joaquin Section of CASCWA is pleased to announce the new scholarship award format and amount. Five (5) awards will be given out this year. Each successful applicant will be awarded an amount of \$1,000.00, and have the ability to receive an additional \$1,000.00 per year for up to three years depending upon the type of post high school program or school the student is attending.

As CASCWA is a nonprofit organization future awards are based upon available funding of the organization. If funding is not available future year's awards will not be distributed. Additional information on subsequent years funding will be provided to the successful applicants.

Make sure your applicants are expected to graduate at the end of the 2017-2018 school year from a high school located within the San Joaquin Section of CASCWA, that is, the school public or private must be located within any of the following counties: *Fresno, Inyo, Kern, Kings, Madera, Mariposa, Merced, Mono, San Benito, San Joaquin, San Luis Obispo, Stanislaus, Tulare and Tuolumne.* • Fresno

Make sure your applicants meet the profile of intended “Anthony Brucia Success Award” recipients. The award is intended for resilient students who have made a turn-around in their lives. The kind of student we want to recognize and honor is the student who most likely did not have a 4.0+ throughout high school. We're looking for a student who has had to overcome lack of success early on due to a variety of reasons, including but not limited to personal or family problems. We want to acknowledge and support those students who may have been burdened by “at risk” circumstances and/or may have “hit bottom” but are now putting things back together and show future promise.
