Student Discipline 101

This webinar is designed for people who are new to student discipline and will focus on the basic requirements of the Education Code for suspension and expulsion due process, as well as the requirements for progressive discipline before imposing suspension and expulsion penalties.

The American Flag, "Tomorrow's Leaders," and Social Media: Update on Student Free Speech Rights

Schools can prohibit students from wearing shirts emblazoned with the American flag? Schools cannot require students to wear a school uniform because it contains the logo "Tomorrow's leaders"? It's protected free speech when a student mocks a teacher and principal on a social media website, but not if they purportedly joke with a friend about bringing a gun to school? The answer to each of these questions is yes. This presentation will cover the wide range of new student speech opinions issued by courts in the Ninth Circuit and around the nation, and explain how and why the courts reached the conclusions they did. Attendees will leave this presentation with a comprehensive understanding of the trends on student speech, when it is and is not okay to regulate student speech or otherwise discipline students for their expression.

Student Transfers and Appeals
